

Once upon a time, seasonal and holiday decorating in America meant many homes in a typical neighborhood had blow mold figurines. Made of durable, brightly colored plastic and usually containing plug-in lights, decorations in the shapes of pumpkins, snowmen and more gave off an inviting glow on a brisk evening. Around since the 1940s, blow molds reached their peak in the '70s. Though retailers are bringing back the trend by producing new molds, vintage pieces are even more popular, whether passed down from a relative or purchased at an antique store.
